

Our policy on Health and safety



Our management of health and safety issues is central to our work. This policy explains how we maintain the health and safety of our residents, staff and others affected by our organisation.

We are committed to meeting our obligations under health and safety law, and aim to keep up with changes in the law and good practice. Everyone at THCH is responsible for working safely and everyone has health and safety responsibilities.

The details are set out in our full Health and Safety Policy.

Our key health and safety commitments

- We will meet legally required health and safety standards at all of our properties, including the communal areas at the residential schemes we own or manage.
- We will identify health and safety risks and take action to minimise them.
- We will make sure our employees, Board members, temporary and contract staff, members of the public and residents know about our standards, systems and practices, and keep to them.
- We will monitor the health and safety performance of our partners, contractors, agents and others.
- We will consult and involve staff and residents on health and safety matters.
- We will make sure our staff have the training, knowledge, skills, equipment and supervision they need to carry out their roles and work safely.

To make sure we continue to improve in this area, we have a set of key performance indicators for health and safety, which are monitored by the relevant directors, heads of service, Committees and the Board.

We provide the Board with an annual report on health and safety management.
